RESPONSIBILITIES: Works in an interdisciplinary team providing case management, community supports, and active treatment to consumers who have a serious mental illness. Responsibilities include: assessment, treatment planning, coordination and monitoring of supports according to a person centered plan. Services are provided primarily in community settings with an effort to assure the consumer's inclusion in community activity. This position requires timely and complete documentation, good organizational and time management skills, flexibility, and independence in carrying out responsibilities. This person must be able to work within a team environment and is required to work as a member of Delta County ACT 24 hour response team.

If vacancy is filled as RN/Case Manager, this position will also provide nursing duties.

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelors of Social Work with State of Michigan Licensure as a LBSW or LLBSW, consideration will also be given to State of Michigan Licensed Masters of Social Work (LMSW) or State of Michigan Limited Licensed Masters of Social Work (LLMSW). Qualifications for RN/Case Manager will be the successful completion of a Nursing Program and licensure in the State of Michigan as a Registered Nurse. Preference will be given toward BSN degree. One year of experience working with persons with mental illness, computer skills applicable to clinical documentation and outcome measurement activities and a valid Michigan driver's license are required.
