PROCEDURES

- A. The employee in charge of implementing the recipient's plan of service shall:
 - 1. Provide recipient, parent of a minor child or guardian with notice of the availability of family planning and health information services and, upon request, provider referral assistance to providers of such services.
 - 2. The notice shall include a statement that receiving mental health services does not depend in any way on requesting or not requesting family planning services or health information services.

- B. If another employee receives a request for such information, it shall be referred to the employee in charge of implementing the recipient's plan of service.
