

PPE Protocol in the Community: 9/17/20

- Hand hygiene should be performed before putting on PPE using proper handwashing technique or alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains 60 to 95% alcohol.
- PPE should ideally be put on outside of the home prior to entry into the home or building.
 - Please refer to What Kind of Face Covering to Wear
 - Please refer to How to Put on (Don) PPE
- Ask the person being served and any person that will remain in the room during the meeting to wear a facemask during the visit if able to tolerate and one is available.
- Maintain physical distance of at least 6 feet as much as possible.

****An Exposure to COVID-19 is any contact totaling 15 minutes or more within 6 feet distancing. If within 6 feet distancing cannot be maintained please review with Supervisor immediately****

- PPE should ideally be removed outside of the home/building.
 - Please refer to How to Put on (Don) PPE which includes proper removal of PPE
